Your Request:

1. *What current web filter is in place and when this contract is due to expire?*
2. *What current security awareness training is in place and when this contract is due to expire?*
3. *Lastly, can you please confirm what reseller the trust used to purchase their web filter and security awareness training technologies?*

Please find the Trust's response below:

1. What current web filter is in place and when this contract is due to expire?

The Trust is applying an exemption under Section 31(1)(1) Freedom of Information Act 2000 (Law Enforcement). The application of the exemption is because the Trust assesses that disclosure of the information would likely put Trust systems at risk of an attack. As Section 31 is a qualified exemption, it is subject to a public interest test for determining whether to release the information. The Trust has considered the following:

Factors in favour of disclosure:

- Evidences the Trust's transparency and accountability.
- Reassures the public that the Trust's systems are secure.
- Provides information about how effective the security systems are.

Factors in favour of withholding:

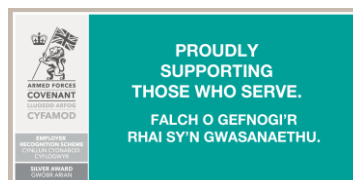
- The public interest in crime prevention and putting the Trust's systems at risk of an attack.
- Public interest in avoiding disruption to public services.
- Public interest in the Trust avoiding the costs associated with any attacks on security.

The Trust believes that the balance of public interest lies in upholding the exemption and withholding the information requested.

2. What current security awareness training is in place and when this contract is due to expire?

All training was created and is undertaken in-house.
